T. Griffin, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Maddox that the Budget for 1946, be adopted as presented with changes agreed to by the Commissioners. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Roland, and Maddox voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Maddox and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Sheriff be allowed \$6360 per year for deputies and \$640 per year for extra deputies and assistants. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Roland and Maddox voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to set the County Attorney's Deputy salary at \$924.00 per year. All voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to adjourn. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Roland and Maddox voted "Aye".
