A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the bid of Hi-Way Machinery Company for 1 tractor and loader for Precinct #4 be accepted. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Maddox that all properly approved accounts be allowed and ordered paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that W. G. Whitehead having exercised his option to lease the County Farm for the year 1946 on the same terms as was leased for the year 1945, and the same be and is hereby leased for 1946 on said terms.
