BE IT REMEMBERED THAT at a Special Meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 23rd day of December, A. D. 1946, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that C. L. Adcock's bid of \$101.50 for a bridge over Martin's branch at Concord be accepted. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, and Roland voted "'Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland to allow W. G. Whitehead \$125.00 for repair of fence on the County Farm. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the bond of William J. Stilwell, Tax Assessor-Collector be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the bid of Acme Brick Co. for brick, tile and glass blocks and other items for the County Hospital be accepted. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Veteran's Administration be submitted a bid upon the 3 rooms in the basement formerly occupied by the O. P. A. for the sum of \$80.00 per month and that the County Judge be authorized to execute the bid

for such space and if the bid is accepted, to execute a lease with the Veteran's Administration.

Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the County pay \$2.50 per month on the telephone to be installed in the office of the Justice of the Peace in the basement of the Court House. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the following schedule for the assessment of tractors be adopted:

1947-1946 -----	60% purchase price
1945 -----	55% purchase price
1944 -----	50% purchase price
1943 -----	45% purchase price
1942 -----	40% purchase price
1941 -----	35% purchase price
1940 & years before -----	30% purchase price.

Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, and Roland voted "Aye".
