Lee, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Walters and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the bid of Hobbs Trailer Co. for one 1- Model A5000 - 13'7" Single Axle Cable Dump Trailer equipped with 8.25 x 20 - 10 ply tires, new style Chevrolet wheels, 14,000 # axle, 16 1/2" x 5" x 3/4" vacuum brakes, cam lift booster fifth wheel, automatic swinging tailgate, sheaves and lines on trailer, ICC lights and directional signals, mud flaps with nameplates, reflectors installed on tailgate, vacuum hand controls on your truck, lower semi-automatic fifth wheel and M6-15 Braden winch package assembly including I Beam mounting, winch mounting angles, fifth wheel hold down brackets, semi-automatic fifth wheel, one speed forward and one speed reverse power-take off and drive line assembly completely installed on your truck and directional lights installed on your truck:
