Lee, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Evans that all just, due and properly endorsed bills against Johnson County be allowed and ordered paid as submitted and examined in open Court. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Evans and seconded by Commissioner Walters that J. E. Summerlin be appointed Justice of the Peace in Precinct 2, Johnson County, Texas, effective upon filing a good and sufficient bond with the County Judge, and ending December 31, 1956. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Evans that the Johnson County Hospital financial report for the month of March, 1956, be approved as submitted and examined in open Court. All voted aye.
