BE IT REMEMBERED at a regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court on the above mentioned date in the Courthouse in Cleburne, Texas, the following members were present: H. G. Littlefair, County Judge, W. M. Coward, Commissioner Precinct 1, S. W. Evans, Commissioner Precinct 2, Jimmie L. Walters, Commissioner Precinct 3, M. W. Roland, Commissioner Precinct 4, and Louis B. Lee, County Clerk.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Coward that all due and properly endorsed bills against Johnson County be allowed and ordered paid as submitted and examined in open court. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Walters and seconded by Commissioner Evans that the bid of Steakley Brothers Chevrolet Company for 1 1956 Chevrolet 2 ton truck, 138 in. wheelbase, 148 H. P. engine, Model 6103, for a net price of \$2,203.30, be accepted. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Walters that the bid of F. E. Gardner in the amount of \$1,860.00 for the Holt property and \$510.00 for the McGowan property be accepted as the highest and best bid offered. Both properties to be moved off lots within thirty days. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Coward tht the budget for Johnson County be adopted as prepared and presented by J. T. Epperson, Jr., County Auditor. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Evans and seconded by Commissioner Roland tht the Auditor be authorized to advertise for one 2 ton truck, short W.B., H.D. radiator, wheels and springs for Precinct 2, Johnson County, Texas. The Court reserves the right to reject any or all bids. Bids to be opened at 9:00 o'clock A. M. September 1, 1956. All voted aye.
