In <u>JOHNSON COUNTY</u> a <u>FARM-TO-MARKET ROAD</u> is hereby designated extending from State 171 near Godley North, a distance of approximately 5.6 miles, subject to the availability of funds in the Farm-to-Market Road fund as established by Senate Bill 287, 51st Legislature, and subject to the condition that Johnson County will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State.

At such time as the County shall accept the provisions of this Order and agree to the furnishing of the required right of way, the State Highway Engineer is directed to proceed with the engineering development and construction of the project in the most feasible and economical manner, at an estimated cost of \$122,000 and to assume the road for State maintenance upon completion of the construction herein authorized.

This Order is subject to acceptance by the County and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically cancelled.
