A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Rayburne that the following Contract be approved.

CONTRACT by and between Johnson County, Texas, hereinafter known as County and J. Sivadon, hereinafter known as Sivadon.

Sivadon proposes to weather-proof the outside surface of all the terra-cotta, pre-cast stone, limestone and granite to a weather-resisting and heat resisting condition, to which will stop the fungus growth as well as moisture seepage from the outside to the inner walls. Also, keep the edifice looking new for many years. (Life estimate 15 to 25 years), as follows:

(1)

Apply one heavy coating of transparent weather-proofing material to the outside surface of all the terra-cotta surface. (M. F. W. Terra-Cotta Sealer). (Flow Method).

(2)

Apply heavy coating of weather-proofing material to the outside surface of all the brick and mortar joints. (M. F. W. Brick Weather-Proofing Material). (Flow Method).

(3)

Apply one heavy coating of transparent Silicone weather-proofing material to all the limestone and granite. (Flow Method).

(4)

All Mortar Joints are to be in a suitable condition for the application of weather-proofing material. All deteriorated faces surfaces of steps are to be finished with dyed proofing material to coincide with granite base. Steeple masonery caps, and corner tower caps are to be treated to coincide with terra-cotta.

Sivadon proposes to furnish all equipment, labor and material, for the sum of \$7630.00.

Sivadon releases County of any personal injuries that might occur while completing said work, and County agrees to pay J. Sivadon the contract price at the completion of said work. Or pay \$100.00 at the completion of said work, balance one year from date of completion of work, at 3% interest. Principle of Contract negotiable without recourse.
