BE IT REMEMBERED at a Regular Meeting of the Commissioners Court on the above mentioned date at the Courthouse in Cleburne, Texas, with the following members were Present: M.W. Roland, Presiding, W.M. Coward, Commissioner of Precinct No.1, W.R. Bryant, Commissioner of Precinct No.2, J.C. (Jim) Rayburne, Commissioner of Precinct No.3, Louis B. Lee, County Clerk, Lorene Moreland, County Auditor, O. Odell Elliott, Assistant County Auditor, John Butner, Jack Park and Noel Wofford, Juvenile Officer.

A motion was made by Commissioner Coward and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that all bills against Johnson County be allowed and ordered paid as submitted, examined in open court and properly endorsed.

All voted aye

A motion was made by Commissioner Coward and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the bond of J. P. Hamilton in the amount of \$7,500.00 as Treasurer of Fire Commissioners, Johnson County Rural Fire District, effective February 28, 1964 to February 28, 1965 be approved.

All voted aye

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Coward that Johnson County hereby agrees to reimburse the Sinclair Pipe Line Company of Independence, Kansas, for the actual costs of adjusting its facilities on proposed FM 2738 in Johnson County as outlined in the proposal from said Sinclair Pipe Line Company to the County Judge of Johnson County, Texas, on February 10, 1964, not to exceed \$1661.33.

All voted aye

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that Johnson County hereby agrees to protect the Texas Highway Department and hold it harmless in the vent any litigation or dispute whatever should arise concerning the title to that tract of right-of-way designated as Parcel 3 on the Texas Highway Department right-of-way map for FM Highway No. 2738. Johnson County further agrees to assume the burden of defending any such action and taking any necessary steps to properly clear the title to said right-of-way.

A motion was made by Commissioner Coward and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that Alta May Wheat be employed as Juvenile Officer to replace Noel Wofford for the month of April 1964, in addition to her other duties and shall be allowed \$100.00 for such extra duty.

A motion was made by Commissioner Coward and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that Sheriff Earl King be authorized to increase the pay of Bob Pollard, Castro Taylor, Stuart Huffman, regular deputies and Carlton Booth extra deputy \$50.00 for the month of April, 1964.
