Open meeting called for the purpose of approving the Johnson County Financial Budget for operating the County during the Fiscal year January 1, 1965 to December 31, 1965 and setting the Tax rate for collection of taxes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland, and seconded by Commissioner Coward that the budget as presented by County Judge Winn and County Auditor Lorene Moreland be approved in all respects and that the tax rate be set as recommended as follows:
