The Commissioner's Court of Johnson County, Texas, has no objection to Parker Water Supply Corporation, a non-profit corporation, locating within the County right-of-way the said Corporations' water line. The right-of-way involved is shown on the accompanying drawing. The actual location of the water line shall be at a location to be approved by Commissioner's Court of Johnson County, Texas. The said water line shall be installed at a depth of not less than 30 inches below the surface of the ground within said right-of way. If at any time after the execution of this contract it should become necessary that the water line be moved for any purpose, the entire cost of moving said water line will be paid for by Parker Water Supply Corporation.

It is expressly understood that the Commissioner's Court does not purport, hereby, to grant any right, claim, title, or easement in or upon this right-of-way. A permit is hereby granted for continuous use.

All work on the County right-of-way shall be performed in accordance with County instructions. The installation shall not damage any part of the County Road and adequate provisions must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent property owners. The herein named County will at no time be held liable for any damage to said water line while improving and maintaining County roads. It is agreed with County that this permit can be assigned to the Farmers Home Administration, as agency of the United States Government for collateral of monies received to construct said water lines.
