Roland, Commissioner, Precinct No.4; Louis B. Lee, County Clerk, Lorene Moreland, County Auditor, O. Odell Elliott, Assistant County Auditor, Noel Wofford, Sheriff, Miss Ponder Lee Brown and Hugh Higgins, County Attorney.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bryant, and seconded by Commissioner Coward all just and due bills against Johnson County be allowed and ordered paid as submitted, examined in open court and properly endorsed.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler, and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that the following application for maintenance on private roads be accepted.

I, the undersigned, do hereby request the Commissioners Court of Johnson County to authorize the Commissioner of Precinct Number 2 to direct the use of County employees and equipment to construct and maintain, to-wit: Section and chug holes need repairing the following described private road, to-wit: Front on lots in Wildwood Estates, South of Burleson, Texas.

I understand that I will be charged an amount equal to the prevailing charges for like work in the same area. I agree to pay said charge.

Whereas, it has been brought to my attention of the Commissioners Court that there are one or more gates or fences across the Right of Way of County Road 1114, which is outside the corporate limits of any city, and

Whereas, said County Road 1114 is a public road of the first or second class;

It is therefore ordered that all gates and fences be removed from that portion of the right-of-way on County Road 1114, which lies outside limits of any city;

It is further ordered that no gates, fences or other obstructions be placed within said right-of-way hereafter;

It is further ordered that a copy of this order be mailed or delivered to all parties now or hereafter in violation of this order.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that the County pay for one air conditioner unit for Highway patrolman Billy Roe's car, with the understanding that he and his successor will be responsible for repairs and transfer to any other car and that the conditioner last at least 6 years.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that the Sheriff's receive bids for 2 air conditioners to be installed in Sheriff's Cars and submit bids for Court action.

All voted aye.
