TO THE HONORALBE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SAID COURT:

The undersigned, Texas Telephone and Telegraph Company, desires to locate within the County right-of-ways of the County roads buried telephone cables, in, over and across said roadways.

Said cables shall be installed and located in accordance with the following conditions and agreements:

1. The actual physical location of the cable shall be a location to be approved by the Commissioners' Court and the telephone company will give a minimum of 48 hours notice to the Commissioner of said

precinct, in which said cable is located prior to commencing the actual physical location of any such cable.

2. Said cable shall be installed at a depth of not less than 30" below the surface of the ground within said right-of-way.
3. If after the granting of this permit, it should ever become necessary for the cable to be moved for any purpose, such costs of same will be paid for, in its entirety, by the telephone company.
4. Any and all work to be performed on said county right-of way roadways shall be performed in accordance with the county instructions and said installation shall not damage a part of the county road and adequate provisions will be made during such construction period, to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and to adjacent property owners.
5. The County at no time will be liable for damage to the cables while maintaining, and improving its county road system.
6. all future maintenance and installations of additional cables shall be controlled under the terms of this said permit.
7. this permit shall be for such period as the telephone company has cables installed in and through Johnson County rendering telephone service.
8. It is expressly understood that the Commissioners Court does not purport, hereby, to grant any right, title, claim, or easement in or upon said right-of-way.

WHEREFORE, the Commissioner's Court is requested to issue to the undersigned a permit for the installation of such cables, subject to the terms and conditions as set out herein.
