SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, made as of the 26th day of September, 1966, between The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a Kansas corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Santa Fe", and Johnson County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, acting herein by its County Judge, hereto as "Second Party".

R E C I T A L S:

Santa Fe and Second Party are now parties to a contract dated July 1, 1957, Santa Fe's secretary's Contract No. 33863, together with any and all modifications, supplements and amendments thereto, being hereinafter referred to as "Original Contract", under which Second Part pays Santa Fe a compensation of \$72.00 per year for the use of a portion of Santa Fe property at or near, Joshua, Johnson County, Texas as a site for a warehouse and storing equipment.

The parties desire to modify the Original Contract as hereinafter provided.

AGREEMENT:

It is mutually agreed that effective April 1, 1967 the compensation section of the Original Contract is hereby changed to read as follows:

"Second Party shall pay to Santa Fe on or before the first day of each period of one year during the continuance of this contract as compensation for the use of the Premises for such period the sum of Ninety-six and No/100 Dollars (\$96.00). Santa Fe may revise the amount of compensation after the end of each five (5) year period during which this contract may remain in effect, and without affecting the right of either party hereto to terminate this contract at any time as may be provided elsewhere herein."

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Supplemental Agreement in duplicate as of the day and year first above written.

SERVICE AGREEMENT AND CHARGE FOR WORK:

This agreement will be for one year. After the first year, service will continue on a monthly rate until either party notified the other by written notice thirty (30) days in advance to cancel.

The Charge will be \$300.00 per year payable at \$25.00 per month.
