BE IT REMEMBERED at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court in and for Johnson County, Texas, on the above mentioned date at the Courthouse in Cleburne, Texas, with the following members present: Herschel C. Winn, County Judge, Winnie Coward, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1, W.R. Bryant, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, W.I. Boteler, Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, M.W. Roland, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, Louis B. Lee, County Clerk, Lorene Moreland, County Auditor, J. C. Bennett, Assistant County Auditor, Col Williams, County Agent and Orland Eash.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that all bills against Johnson County be allowed & ordered paid, as submitted, examined in open court & properly endorsed.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Bryant and seconded by Commissioner Boteler which motion passed unanimously the Commissioners Court of Johnson County hereby authorizes the Commissioner shown below to use County employees and equipment to construct and/or maintain a private road within his precinct as shown below, as authorized by Article 6812b, Texas Civil Statutes; to-wit:

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Boteler that the County Agents budget be amended in the amount of \$600.00 for the Brucellousis program.

A motion was made by the Commissioner Coward and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that the County Auditor be authorized to advertise for bids on one Motor Grader for Precinct #1m Johnson County, Texas. One heavey duty motor grader. Tandem drive, minimum 100 H.P., Diesel Engine, double plate oil type clutch, power steering, hydraulic or mechanical control, 12" moldboard, leaning front wheels, power circle reverse, 13.00 X 24.8 ply tires, minimum weight 22,800 lbs. without extras, with trade-in of TD14 Dozier & 104 Galian Motor Grader.

Bids to be opened at 10:00 A. M. on April 1st 1968, the county reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Boteler that the order passed and approved on September 20, 1965, and recorded in Volume 15, Page 48 of the Commissioners Court Minutes allowing the County Commissioner 7 cents per mile for travel expenses out of the County be amended to read 10 cents per mile out of the County expense, effective March 1, 1968.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that the following Resolution be approved.

WHEREAS, there have been a question at to the length of County Road 401B: and,

WHEREAS, in order for the Commissioner of Precinct 4 to known which portion of County Road 401B is to be maintained by the County of Johnson and which is to be considered a private road;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVES by the Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas, that it finds that County Road 401B is 6,500 feet from its intersection with FM 2415 toward the North and that the same is to be considered a part of the County Road System and maintained by Johnson County. That the portion North of a point 6,500 feet north of the intersection of FM 2415 and County Road 401B is to be considered a private road and not to be maintained by the Commissioner except as authorized under private road road.
