A question was raised to the location of the Precinct Line between Commissioners Precinct 3 and Commissioner Precinct 4. Commissioner Boteler requested an interpretation of this description by the Commissioners Court. It appearing to the Court that a portion of County Road 405 had been closed and straightened to allow it to cross the bridge over Interstate 35W and if you followed a literal interpretation of the description of the Precinct Line,

American Telephone and Telegraph Line did not cross County Road 405 until it was west of old US 81. This not being the intention of the Commissioners Court at the time of setting the Precinct Lines, the Commissioners Court ruled that the Precinct Line follows American Telephone and Telegraph line in a westerly direction crossint Interstate Highway 35W to the center of old County Road 405, which lies south of the residence of Raymond Tackett; thence west, north and west following the old abandoned County Road 405 to the center of County Road the present 405. Thence with center of County Road 405 to County Road 316. Commissioner Boteler made a motion that this interpretation be passed by the Commissioners Court, and Commissioner Roland seconded.
