Winn, County Judge, Winnie Coward, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1, W. R. Bryant, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, M. W. Roland, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, and Louis B. Lee, County Clerk.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that WHEREAS, Johnson County, Texas, has a portion of the surplus in the County and District Road Highway Funds as of August 31, 1968, in the amount of \$46,552.54, the Commisssioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, hereby request that the Board of County and District Indebtedness refund to Johnson County, in the amount of \$46,552.54 which represents Johnson County's portion of the surplus in the County and District Road Highway Fund.

The 1968 Texas Farm to Market Road Program recently approved by the Texas Highway Commission includes the designation and construction of two farm to market roads in Johnson County.

Highway Commission Minute Order No. 61126, dated July 11, 1968, authorizing the designation and construction of a farm to market road from State Highway 171 at Godley, southwest to F.M. 1192, a distance of approximately 4.9 miles, and designation and construction of a farm to market road from F.M. 110, 1.5 miles east of State Highway 171, northeast to road intersection, a distance of approximately 6.1 miles.

MINUTE ORDER

In JOHNSON COUNTY, IT IS ORDERED That the following described roads be designated as FARM TO MARKET ROADS, subject to the condition that Johnson County will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State:

From State Highway 171 at Godley, Southwest to F.M. Road 1192, a distance of approximately 4.9 miles.

From F.M. Road 110, 1.5 miles East of State Highway 171, Northeast to Road Intersection, a distance of approximately 6.1 miles.

At such time as the County shall accept the provision of this order and agree to the furnishing of the required right of way, the State Highway Engineer is directed to proceed with the engineering development and construction of Grading and Structures in the most feasible and economical number, at an estimated cost of \$180,000, and to assume the roads for State maintenance upon completion of the construction herein authorized.

This Order is subject to acceptance by the County and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically cancelled.

From State Highway 171 at Godley, Southwest to F.M. 1192, a distance of approximately 4.19 miles.

From F.M. 110, 1.5 miles East of State Highway 171, Northeast to Road Intersection, a distance of approximately 6.1 miles.
