BE IT REMEMBERED AT A SPECIAL MEETING of the Commissioners' Court in and for Johnson County, Texas, on the above mentioned date at the Courthouse at Cleburne, Texas, with the following members present: Thomas E. Ball, County Judge, C. W. Atwood, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1, W. R. Bryant, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, W. I. Boteler, Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, M. W. Roland, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, Louis B. Lee, County Clerk, John Butner, H. M. Hughes, Carl Abbott, Carlie Skelton, H. E. Kennon and John MacLean, County Attorney.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the bid of H. M. (Skip) Hughes to build new right of way fences of 11¢ a foot be accepted. This figure includes clearing of fence line and water gaps. There will be an extra 1¢ a foot charge where it is necessary to roll the old wire. Also use of the County equipment for fence building will be made available. This figure or figures does not include cattle guards or cyclone fencing.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Boteler that the bid of H. M. Hughes to furnish the material and labor to build cyclone fence for Nola Hargrove, J. C. Bledsoe and relocate cyclone fence of D. A. Owens, be accepted. Bid for labor and material-\$595.62.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bryant and seconded by Commissioner Boteler that the County order 1000 road signs for County roads from Keene Advertising Company, Keene, Texas, at price to be named later, if the price is suitable and satisfactory to the County.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Roland that Earl Travis be employed to paint the Courthouse clock face, at pay of \$50.00 each face.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Bryant with motion passed unanimously the Commissioners Court of Johnson County hereby authorizes the Commissioner shown below to use County employees

and equipment to construct and/or maintain a private road within his precinct as shown below, as authorized by Article 6812b, Texas Civil Statutes, to-wit:
