SPECIAL USE PERMIT

The undersigned Judge of the County Court in and for Johnson County, Texas, in accordance with the authority granted to me under Section 2, Article 827a, Vernon's Texas Penal Code, hereby grants a permit to the United States of America, hereinafter called the Government, to use any and all roads in the said county of Johnson, Texas, at any and all times during the following inclusive dates;

1 May 1972 thru 31 December 1974

The Government agrees to be responsible for any and all damages to said roads arising from the activity of the Government, its officers, agents, employees or representatives, in the exercise or rights under this permit, either by repairing such damage or making a cash settlement to the appropriate county officials.
