BE IT REMEMBERED AT A REGULAR MEETING of the Commissioners' Court in and for Johnson County, Texas, on the above mentioned date at the Courthouse in Cleburne, Texas, with the following members present: Thomas E. Ball, County Judge C.W. Atwood, Commissioner Precinct No.1, O.B. Hadley, Commissioner Precinct No.2, W.I. Boteler, Commissioner Precinct No.3, B.B. Aldridge, Commissioner Precinct No.4; and Joe L. Townes, County Clerk.

The invocation was given by Commissioner Hadley to approve the reading of the minutes of the Commissioners' Court previous meetings.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to accept the donation to Johnson County of the R.A. Kilpatrick Law Library from the late R.A. Kilpatrick.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Atwood to set the following speed limits on County Roads:

Gravel roads: - Truck 25 M.P.H.
Passenger Cars 35 M.P.H.

Hard-Top Roads: Truck 35 M.P.H.
Passenger Cars 50 M.P.H.

Dirt Roads: All vehicles maintain a safe speed.

And set the gross weight at 15.000 lbs. per axle, maximum total weight 45.000 lbs. on all County road bridges and to post and file with the County Clerk the load limit of each bridge in each county precinct.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Atwood to approve the re-platting of two lots in Westridge Terrace Addition, Johnson County, Texas.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to approve the Commissioner of Precinct No.4 to contract street work with City of Grandview. City of Grandview to pay full cost of labor and material.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to approve Commissioner of Precinct No.4 to contract street work with City of Grandview. City of Grandview to pay full cost of labor and material.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to authorize the County Auditor to invest \$34,000.00 in Certificate of Deposit out of the 1967 refunding bond for 90 days.

\$37,500.00 Certificate of deposit out of the Right-of-Way Fund for 30 days, and \$37,500.00. Certificate of Deposit out of the Right-of-Way Fund for 90 days.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to approve the following resolution:

C.W. Atwood, Precinct No.1, and W.I. Boteler, Precinct No.3, were appointed by Judge Ball to serve as a committee to study and recommended the re-alignment of Commissioners' Precincts.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by B.B. Aldridge, Commissioner Precinct No.4 to approve the payment of monthly bills, with the exception of the Texas Surplus property bill.

All voted aye.
