BE IT REMEMBERED AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT IN AND FOR JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS, on the above-mentioned date at the courthouse in Cleburne, Texas with the following members present: Thomas E. Ball, County Judge; C.W. Atwood, Commissioner Precinct No.1; O.B. Hadley, Commissioner Precinct No.2; W.I. Boteler, Commissioner No.3; B.B. Aldridge, Commissioner Precinct No.4; Joe L. Townes, County Clerk.

The invocation was given by Commissioner W.I. Boteler.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge to authorize O.B. Hadley, Commissioner Precinct No. 2, to apply pea gravel and asphalt to city streets in the City of Godley Texas if the law permits.

All voted aye.

The Court instructed the County Judge to request the State Highway Department to bring the Johnson County road maps up-to-date, showing the road mileage in each precinct.

Three residents appeared before the court requesting a road about 900' long connecting county road #603 and #531 be maintained by the county. This request was taken under advisement and referred to the County Attorney to determine if same is or is not a county road.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to grade, level and black-top an area around the Y.M.C.A. building in Cleburne, Johnson County Texas; Johnson County Commissioners to furnish the labor, equipment and material. This is subject to the legal opinion of the County Attorney.

All voted aye.

Mrs. Viola Black and other members of the Johnson County Historical Society appeared before the court seeking assistance in having a log cabin moved to the City Park in Cleburne. Mr. Bill Atwood, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, agreed to work with the committee and would move the log cabin for them when a definite site has been obtained.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge to approve the certificate of cancellation of county taxes due to errors in the rolls and other reasons: Pages 3564 through 3600.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to authorize County Auditor Robert Wylie to accept bids on a new car for the Sheriff's Department.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to approve payment of monthly bills.

All voted aye.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, Court adjourned.
