 - 2. Extend C.R. #1205 to Hill County line and make F.M. road
- Precinct No. 2 1. Make C.R. #1022 from #917 west of Joshua into Cleburne a F.M. road; ,ale F.M. #1902 intersect Highway 67.
 - 2. Make C.R. #1016 a F.M. road to connect with F.M. #731 west of Burleson.
 - 3. Make C.R. #805 off #917 east of Joshua into Cleburne a F.M. road.
- Precinct No. 3 1. Extend F.M. #3211 to include C.R. #3136.
 - 2. Make C.R. #807 north into Egan a county road.
- Precinct No. 4 1. Make C.R. #401, old U.S. #81, into a F.M. road.
 - 2. Extend F.M. #2415 east to I.S. #35.
