BE IT REMEMBERED AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT IN AND FOR JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS, on the above-mentioned date at the courthouse in Cleburne, Texas with the following members present: C.W. Atwood, Commissioner Precinct No.1; O.B. Hadley, Commissioner Precinct No.2; W.I. Boteler, Commissioner No.3; B.B. Aldridge, Commissioner Precinct No.4 and Joe L. Townes, County Clerk.

Commissioner W.I. Boteler presided.

The invocation was given by Commissioner C.W. Atwood.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge to approve the minutes of previous meetings as read.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to increase the number of board of directors of the Johnson County Hospital Authority by two members; making a total of ten members on the board of directors.

All voted aye.

The Court ruled that the connecting road between County Road #603 and County Road #531 is not a county road; and, the county will not maintain same.

A motion was made by Commissioner C.W. Atwood and seconded by Commissioner O.B. Hadley to approve the Public Official's bond of Carla Oefinger in amount of \$5,000.00; a deputy of the District Clerk's office.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge to approve payment of the monthly bills.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to grant Dennis McWilliams, Tax Collector-Assessor, the authority to employ Pritchard and Abbott to make utility, industrial, and mining appraisals for Johnson County at a rate of \$0.06 per \$100.00 evaluation.

The following voted "aye": Commissioner C.W. Atwood; Commissioner W.I. Boteler; Commissioner W.I. Boteler. Commissioner B.B. Aldridge voted "no."
