A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that all future bills for fighting fires in Johnson County be forwarded to the Rural Fire Fighting Commission. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to approve for payment the bill for child support allowance for Rosemarie Van Orden in the amount of \$108.35 payable to Mrs. Opal Richardson.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge to pay the monthly bills as read by the County Auditor.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to authorize Commissioner Boteler, Precinct #3, to purchase front-end loader that has been currently on a lease-purchase agreement.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to authorize the County Auditor to advertise for bids on a front-end loader for Precinct #4.
