BE IT REMEMBERED AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT IN AND FOR JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS, on the above-mentioned date at the courthouse in Cleburne, Texas with the following members present: Thomas E. Ball, county Judge; C.W. Atwood, Commissioner Precinct No.1; O.B. Hadley, Commissioner Precinct No.2; W.I. Boteler, Commissioner No.3; B.B. Aldridge, Commissioner Precinct No.4 and Joe L. Townes, County Clerk.

The invocation was given by Commissioner C.W. Atwood.

Mrs. Mary Nell White, Secretary of the Selective Services, appeared before the Court thanking them for her office space and advised the court that her office is now serving a five-county area consisting of Johnson, Hood, Somervell, Erath, and Bosque counties. The office is now open four days a week, Monday through Thursday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Mrs. E.D. Wilson, Grandview, appeared before the Court requesting appointment as constable Precinct No. 4 for the un-expired term of her husband, E.D. Wilson, deceased. No action was taken until B.B. Aldridge, Commissioner Precinct No. 4, is present.

No action was taken by the court on a request from the City of Burleson for ambulance service.

The Order on Abandonment of a portion of old Highway 67, as submitted for approval, was referred to the County Attorney for his decision.

A request from the Board of Directors of Johnson County Memorial Hospital to appoint an advisory board of directors (with no voting power) consisting of:

was passed for further study by the court.

The County auditor was authorized to re-advertise for bids on a flat-bed trailer for the Commissioner of Precinct NO. 2; to include a trade-in on old trailer.

Due to the absence of the commissioner of Precinct NO. 4; no action was taken on the low bid of \$28,294.00 by Brazos Equipment Co. on a front-end loader for Precinct No. 4.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to authorize the county auditor to have repairs made to the highway patrol office in the basement of the courthouse and to install a telephone with one extension; and to have the necessary repairs made to the sheriff's office in the county jail to accommodate a private office for the radio dispatcher.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to authorize the payment of the monthly bills.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Atwood to adjourn.
