Invocation was given by Judge Cooke.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to approve the following resolution appointing Dr. Arthur Raines, Johnson County Health Officer, for two (2) yrs. Effective July 1, 1976 @ \$300.00 per month.
