COMMISSIONERS' COURT

BE IT KNOWN that on this the 16th day of November, 1987, the Honorable Commissioners' Court of Johnson County met in the Courthouse in the City of Cleburne in a special called session with all members present and considered the following:

CONSIDERATIONS

1. AWARD BIDS ON JOHNSON COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

Motion was made by Comm. Roe, seconded by Comm. Harmon, to accept the low bids of Stegemoller Construction of \$5,661.00 for the extension of sanitary sewer, and from Dan Buckner, Inc., of \$31,446.60, for the extension of the streets for the Johnson County Law Enforcement Center.

All voted aye; motion passed.

APPROVAL OF BILLS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF JOHNSON COUNTY LAW
ENFORCEMENT CENTER

Motion was made by Comm. York, seconded by Comm. Miller, to approve the payment of the following bills for the Law Enforcement Center:

Joe Adams & Sons	\$51,003.00
Parkey & Partners	\$2,750.00
Danny Butler Construction	\$16,000.00

All voted aye; motion passed.

SUBDIVISIONS

2. WHITE WING ESTATES

Motion was made by Comm. Harmon, seconded by Comm. York, to approve the County accepting maintenance of the roads in the White Wing Estates subdivision, said roads having been maintained

by the developer for at least two years after they were completed.

All voted aye; motion passed.

3. THE VILLAGE

Motion was made by Comm. York, seconded by Comm. Miller, to approve the County accepting maintenance of the roads in the Village subdivision, said roads having been maintained by the developer for at least two years after they were completed.

All voted aye; motion passed.

4. CLOSING OF COUNTY ROAD 1104

Motion was made by Comm. Miller, seconded by Comm. Harmon, to rescind the closing of County Road 1104 because all of the adjoining property owners and property owners having access to the road were not included in the petition to close the road and were not notified of the petition being filed.

All voted aye; motion passed.

1. AWARD BIDS ON JOHNSON COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

No action was taken.

SUBDIVISIONS

1. SHADYWOOD ADDITION

Motion was made by Comm. Roe, seconded by Comm. Miller to authorize the County Attorney to write the developer, Otis Percifield, a letter concerning bringing the Chambers Creek Development, Shadywood I and Shadywood II subdivisions into compliance with the subdivision regulations.

All voted aye; motion passed.

CONSIDERATIONS

3. AWARD OF BID ON CENTRAL COMPUTER SYSTEM

Motion was made by Comm. Harmon, seconded by Comm. Miller, to approve a five year lease-purchase agreement and installment purchase agreement with IBM and Northeast Data for the purchase of hardware for the data processing, County Clerk, and Tax Office, and computer software.

All voted aye; motion passed.

4. ADVERTISING FOR BIDS

Motion was made by Comm. Roe, seconded by Comm. York, to authorize the Commissioner of Precinct No. 4 advertising for the purchase of a used diesel truck.

All voted aye; motion passed.

5. PURCHASES FROM \$1,000.00 TO \$5,000.00

Motion was made by Comm. Miller, seconded by Comm. York, to authorize the Commissioner of Precinct No. 2 to purchase two or three radios at a cost of more than \$1,000.00 and less than \$5,000.00.

All voted aye; motion passed.
