BE IT KNOWN that on the 2nd day of April, 1990, the Honorable Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, met in special session with all members present, in the Courthouse in the City of Cleburne, Johnson County, Texas, and the following items were considered:

1990 CENSUS AND REDISTRICTING OF JOHNSON County Clerk

A motion was made by Comm. Estes, seconded by Comm. Miller, to approve employing Dr. David Guinn for the redistricting of Johnson County after the 1990 Census at an estimated cost of \$16,000.00 to \$20,000.00 with the estimated expenses being \$1,000.00 to \$1,500.00

All voted aye; motion passed.

COURTHOUSE REPAIR

A motion was made by Comm. Hewlett, seconded by Comm. Estes, to approve refinishing the woodwork in the hallways of the Courthouse at an estimated cost of \$10,710.00 and painting the hallways in the Courthouse at an estimated cost of \$4,000.00.

All voted aye; motion passed.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Commissioners' Court went into Executive Session at 10:00 A.M. to discuss a Litigation matter of Johnson County vs. Methodist Affiliated Hospitals and personnel matters concerning the Personnel and Payroll System.
