# 2. <u>CONSIDERATION TO APPOINT A PHYSICIAN FOR THE JAIL MEDICAL</u> EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008

Comm. Matthews, seconded by Comm. McFall, made a motion to appoint Dr. Kris H. Wusterhausen D.O., P.A. as Physician for the Jail Medical Effective July 1, 2008, and enter into a Professional Services contract. This is considered a professional service under Government Code Chapter 2254 and he has been selected on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualifications to perform the service for a fair and reasonable price.

3. CONSIDERATION OF **ORDER # 2008-12** ADOPTING AN OPTIONAL LIMITATION ON TAX INCREASES FOR RESIDENCE HOMESTEADS OF PERSONS WHO ARE DISABLED OR AT LEAST 65 YEARS OF AGE PURSUANT TO **SECTION § 11.261**, TEXAS TAX CODE AS TO THE MARKET/LATERAL ROAD TAXES

Carpenter, made a motion to approve **Order #2008-12** adopting an optional limitation on tax increases for residence homesteads of persons who are disabled or at least 65 years of age pursuant to **Section § 11.261**, Texas Tax Code as to the Market/Lateral Road taxes.
