The meeting was called to order at 9:04 A.M., with all members present, and following the Invocation led by E. J. Barnes, Field Street Baptist Church, and the Pledge of Allegiance, the following items, having been lawfully posted and filed for record in the Office of the County Clerk on June 5, 2014 at 1:17 P.M., were considered:
