Stringer, made a motion to approve **RFP 2015-512** Paramedic Care and Ambulance Service for Johnson County with the following corrections; page 25, paragraph J, wording changed to “Proposer must establish an ambulance charge fee”, the second correction is page 26, paragraph O, #1, the City of Mansfield be added to the cities that are the exceptions to the service being provided and to authorize the Purchasing Agent to distribute this RFP as soon as the changes are made.
