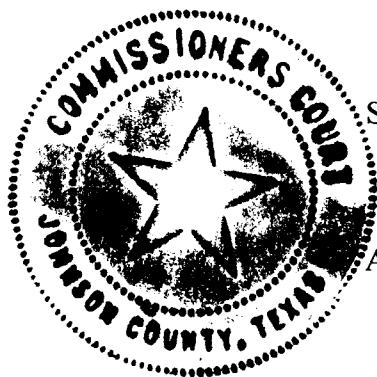
I. NEW BUSINESS
