All Deputy Official Court Reporters shall be paid at the rate of \$307.69 per day, pursuant to Texas Government Code 52.042.




Johnson County will pay mileage for Deputy Official Court Reporter in the amount set by the Commissioners Court for Johnson County employees.


INDIGENT CRIMINAL APPEALS



Copies of exhibits will be compensated for at the rate of 60 cents per page. The cost of binders and binding, as well as deliveries, will be included in the above per page rates. All postage costs will be reimbursed to the Court Reporters in all indigent appeals.


