
WHEREAS, Open Door Ministries have fed people in Johnson County for 14 plus years and they spread the Word of God through generosity and the spirit of giving.




and encourage all citizens of Johnson County to fight hunger and need by joining a charitable organization which serves the people of our County and makes a difference in the lives of our citizens.
