## COMMISSIONERS COURT AUTHORIZATION TO CARRY HANDGUN

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on January 14, 2013 in executive session to consider the following:

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS

A motion was made by Commissioner Jerry Stringer and seconded by Commissioner Don Beeson that the following action be taken by the court:

Pursuant to Article 46.03 (a) (3) of the Texas Penal Code, the Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby authorize elected officials and employees of Johnson County, Texas; elected officials of the State of Texas; elected officials of a City in Johnson County, Texas; and elected trustees of an independent school district in Johnson County, Texas, to carry a handgun in the Johnson County Courthouse located at 2 North Main Street, Cleburne, Texas 76033, if the elected official, employee, or trustee is a concealed handgun license holder under the authority of Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Texas Government Code. This authorization to carry a handgun in the Johnson County Courthouse located at 2 North Main Street, Cleburne, Texas 76033, does not include authorization of an elected official, employee, or trustee to carry a handgun in the Justice of the Peace Precinct Number Four Courtroom or the offices utilized by the Justice of the Peace Precinct Number Four located in the Johnson County Courthouse. Further, this authorization to carry a handgun in the Johnson County Courthouse located at 2 North Main Street, Cleburne, Texas 76033, does not include authorization of an elected official, employee, or trustee to carry a handgun on the premises of a polling place on the day of election or while early voting is in progress.

This ORDER shall become effective as of January 15, 2013. PASSED AND APPROVED at the public meeting of the Johnson County Commissioners Court at which a quorum as present, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2013.
