STATE OF TEXAS §

WHEREAS, Keeping women healthy and promoting awareness of women's health issues, including heart health, is an important responsibility and depends on the actions of many organizations and groups in our community; and

WHEREAS, women's health remains a priority for families, communities, and government, and our commitment to keeping women healthy is stronger than ever; and

WHEREAS, the *National Wear Red Day* campaign and its *Red Dress* symbol are building awareness of women's heart disease risk and empowering them to reduce their risk and prevent heart disease; and

WHEREAS, Johnson County women need to take action to make heart health a priority for themselves and their families, become aware of their heart disease risk, and take action to control their risk;


“National Wear Red Day”
