COUNTY OF JOHNSON

TO GRANT AN EXEMPTION FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF *SECTION 262.023* OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE FOR THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICE OF AN ARCHITECT PURSUANT TO *SECTION 262.024* OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE AND TO INCLUDE *SECTION 2254.003* OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE AS A BASIS TO SELECT AN ARCHITECT

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on August 27, 2012 in regular session for the purpose to grant an exemption for the requirements of *Section 262.023* of the Local Government Code for the professional service of an architect pursuant to *Section 262.024* of the Local Government Code and to award the architect service for the Alvarado Sub-Courthouse located in Johnson County, Texas, Precinct #3, to Magee Architects, L.P. The Commissioners Court approved said exemption and awarded the architect service to Magee Architects, L.P. for the Alvarado Sub-Courthouse by approving Order #2012-17.

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on February 11, 2013 in regular session for the purpose of amending Order #2012-17 to include *Section 2254.003* of the Government Code as a basis to select Magee Architects, L.P. to provide services for the Alvarado Sub-courthouse located in Johnson County, Texas, Precinct #3.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:


