## FEE SCHEDULE FOR JOHNSON COUNTY COURT REPORTERS (Effective October 1, 2013)

All Deputy Official Court Reporters shall be paid at the rate of \$284.35 per day, pursuant to Texas Government Code 52.042.

## INDIGENT CRIMINAL APPEALS

Official Court Reporters and Deputy Official Court Reporters shall be paid \$4.75 per page for an original and two copies on all indigent criminal appeals. Copies of exhibits will be compensated for at the rate of 50 cents per page. The cost of binders and binding, as well as deliveries, will be included in the above per page rates. All postage costs will be reimbursed to the Court Reporters in all indigent appeals.




