- WHEREAS, the crime of domestic violence violates an individual's privacy and dignity, security and humanity, due to systematic use of physical, emotional, sexual, psychological and economic control and/or abuse including abuse to children and the elderly; and
- WHEREAS, the problems of domestic violence effect men, women, and children alike, are not confined to any gender, group or groups of people, but cut across all economic, racial and societal barriers, and are supported by societal indifferences; and
- WHEREAS, the impact of domestic violence is wide ranging, directly affecting individuals and society as a whole, here in this community, throughout the United States and the world; and
- WHEREAS, according to data from the Texas Department of Public Safety, 114 women were killed by an intimate partner in Texas in 2012; and
- WHEREAS, in 2013, Johnson County had 951 incidents of violence reported. (This total comes from the TXDPS Texas Crime Report for 2013); and
- WHEREAS, a coalition of organizations in our county work diligently to confront this crisis, including the Johnson County Family Crisis Center, law enforcement, health care providers, churches, and other concerned citizens are helping in the effort to end domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, survivors of domestic violence themselves have been at the forefront of efforts to bring peace and equality to the home.

**NOW THEREFORE,** in recognition of the important work done by domestic violence programs, I, Roger Harmon, County Judge of Johnson County, and we the Commissioners of the four Precincts in Johnson County, Texas, do hereby proclaim the month of October 2014 as
