IF THE COURT AMENDS THE ORIGINAL BUDGET TO MEET AN EMERGENCY, THE COURT SHALL FILE A COPY OF ITS ORDER AMENDING THE BUDGET WITH THE COUNTY CLERK, AND THE CLERK SHALL ATTACH THE COPY TO THE ORIGINAL BUDGET. (Section 111.041, Local Government Code, Vernon’s Texas Codes Annotated)



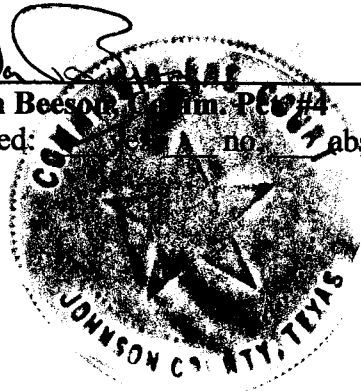

IF THE COURT AMENDS THE ORIGINAL BUDGET TO MEET AN EMERGENCY, THE COURT SHALL FILE A COPY OF ITS ORDER AMENDING THE BUDGET WITH THE COUNTY CLERK, AND THE CLERK SHALL ATTACH THE COPY TO THE ORIGINAL BUDGET.
