COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNEMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON A FINDING THAT THE REPAIRS TO THE JOHNSON COUNTY JAIL ARE AN ITEM NECESSARY TO PRESERVE OR PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF JOHNSON COUNTY

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on February 2, 2015 in a special called session for the consideration of repairs to the Johnson County Jail. The Commissioners Court finds that the repairs to the Johnson County Jail are an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jerry Stringer and seconded by Commissioner Rick Bailey that: "The Commissioners Court find that the repairs to the Johnson County Jail are an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, regarding repairs to the Johnson County Jail."

Said motion was approved by unanimous vote of the Commissioners Court on the  $2^{nd}$  day of February, 2015.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, for the repairs to the Johnson County Jail upon the Commissioners Court finding that the repairs to the Johnson County Jail are an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County.
