- WHEREAS, We wish to pay tribute to the service members who have not returned from the battlefield; to stand beside their families and honor those who are held captive as prisoners of war while we pledge to never forget their sacrifice, nor ever abandon our responsibility to do everything in our power to bring them home; and

WHEREAS, Johnson County residents realize our work is not finished until our heroes are returned safely to our shores or a full accounting is provided to their loved ones and further desire to participate in the national POW/MIA Recognition Day inasmuch as there are families in Johnson County that still await knowledge of their loved-one's whereabouts since as long ago as World War I; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Roger Harmon and we the Commissioners of the four precincts of Johnson County, do hereby proclaim participation of September 18-20, 2015 in observance of

"National POW/MIA Recognition Days"
