**COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION
262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING
REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON
A FINDING THAT THE SERVICES OF CMJ ENGINEERING IS A
PROFESSIONAL SERVICE**

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on September 28, 2015 in regular session for the consideration of the services provided by CMJ Engineering for construction materials testing services on the jail construction project. The Commissioners Court finds that the construction materials testing by CMJ Engineering is for a professional service and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Kenny Howell and seconded by Commissioner Larry Woolley that: "The Commissioners Court find the services provided by CMJ Engineering for construction materials testing services on the jail construction project is a professional service and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, and enter an order to that affect, and that the Commissioners Court approve the services provided by CMJ Engineering for construction materials testing services on the jail construction project.

Said motion was approved by unanimous vote of the Commissioners Court on the 28th day of September, 2015.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:


