COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE REPRESENTATION OF PURDUE, BRANDON, FIELDER, COLLINS & MOTT, L.L.P. IS FOR A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on September 28, 2015 in regular session for the consideration of representation with Purdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins, & Motts, L.L.P. for the collection of delinquent taxes. The Commissioners Court finds that this representation is for a professional service and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Rick Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Kenny Howell that: "The Commissioners Court find the representation with Purdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins, & Motts, L.L.P. for the collection of delinquent taxes is for a professional service and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, and enter an order to that affect, and that the Commissioners Court approve the representation with Purdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins, & Motts, L.L.P. for the collection of delinquent taxes."

Said motion was approved by unanimous vote of the Commissioners Court on the 28th day of September, 2015.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:


