COUNTY OF JOHNSON

COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH YOUTH ADVOCATE PROGRAMS, INC. IS A SERVICE AGREEMENT THAT CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ONLY ONE SOURCE

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on December 14, 2015 in regular session for the consideration of a Service Agreement with Youth Advocate Programs, Inc. to provide advocacy services to youth, ages 12 to 17, living in Johnson County and referred by Johnson County Juvenile Services. The Commissioners Court finds that this advocacy program to provide advocacy services to youth, ages 12 to 17, is a service that can be obtained from only one source and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Larry Woolley and seconded by Commissioner Jerry Stringer that: "The Commissioners Court find that the Service Agreement with Youth Advocate Programs, Inc. to provide advocacy services to youth, ages 12 to 17, living in Johnson County and referred by Johnson County Juvenile Services is a service that can be obtained from only one source and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, and enter an order to that affect, and that the Commissioners Court approve the Service Agreement with Youth Advocate Programs, Inc."

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 14th day of December, 2015.

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the Service Agreement with Youth Advocate Programs, Inc. is a service that can be obtained from only one source.


