WHEREAS, under Section 46.03 of the Texas Penal Code, a person commits an offense if the person intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly possesses or goes with a firearm on the premises of any governmental court or offices utilized by the court, unless pursuant to written regulations or written authorization of the court, and;

WHEREAS, under Section 46.03 (f) of the Texas Penal Code, it is not a defense to prosecution that the actor possessed a handgun and was licensed to carry a handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, and;

WHEREAS, under Section 46.035 (f) (3) of the Texas Penal Code, "Premises" means a building or a portion of a building, and;

WHEREAS, an order is needed to designate the offices essential to the operation of Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 1 Court.

IT IS THEREFORE DESIGNATED AND DECREED, by the presiding Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 1 Court that the following offices are essential to the operations of its court:

- 1. The Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 1 Courtroom
- 2. The Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 1 Judges' Chambers
- 3. The Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 1 Court Clerk Offices
- 4. The Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 1 Court Jury Room
- 5. All hallways and common areas and restrooms located in the building housing Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 1as the hallways and common areas and restrooms are used by jurors, parties, attorneys, witnesses, and judicial personnel.
