ORDER OF JUSTICE OF THE PEACE PRECINCT NUMBER 3 OF ' JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS DESIGNATING OFFICES ESSENTIAL TO THE OPERATION OF ITS COURT

WHEREAS, under Section 46.03 of the Texas Penal Code, a person commits an offense if the person intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly possesses or goes with a firearm on the premises of any governmental court or offices utilized by the court, unless pursuant to written regulations or written authorization of the court, and;

WHEREAS, under Section 46.03 (f) of the Texas Penal Code, it is not a defense to prosecution that the actor possessed a handgun and was licensed to carry a handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, and;

WHEREAS, under Section 46.035 (f) (3) of the Texas Penal Code, "Premises" means a building or a portion of a building, and;

WHEREAS, an order is needed to designate the offices essential to the operation of Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 3 Court.

IT IS THEREFORE DESIGNATED AND DECREED, by the presiding Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 3 Court that the following offices areas are essential to the operations of its court:

- 1. The Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 3 Courtroom
- 2. The Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 3 Judges' Chambers
- 3. The Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 3 Court Clerk Offices
- 4. The Justice of the Peace Precinct Number 3 Court Jury Room
