**COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON A FINDING THAT THE REPAIRS TO THE JOHNSON COUNTY JAIL ARE AN ITEM NECESSARY TO PRESERVE OR PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF JOHNSON COUNTY**

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on February 8, 2016 in a regular session for the consideration of repairs to the Johnson County Jail. The Commissioners Court finds that the repairs to the Johnson County Jail are an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Larry Woolley and seconded by Commissioner Jerry Stringer that: "The Commissioners Court find that the repairs to the Johnson County Jail are an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, regarding repairs to the Johnson County Jail."


Said motion was approved by unanimous vote of the Commissioners Court on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2016.


