Fortunately, we are able to accommodate most of the requests. However, we it to cap the "Polling Place Accessibility." Based on your survey response, the amount that is budgeted for your unty is highlighted below.

e HHS has recently notified the states that grant funds must be drawn down from the federal treasury no later than 10 to 30, 2016. This is a significant deviation from the original September 30, 2016 grant period end date. There has not an avery clear explanation as to why the grant lapse date changed. Regardless, we will move forward.

an effort to expedite the process, we will enter your grant budget in the SOS HAVA grant system for you. In order for to do so, we will need the information outlined below completed and emailed back to our office at nadmin@sos.texas.gov. Once the county has been billed for eligible goods or services, your county financial officer I need to contact our office so we can provide step-by-step instructions for drawing the funds down. It is critical that s happens no later than June 21, 2016 so we have time to draw the funds down from the federal government by June 2016.
