PROCLAMATION

ANTIQUÉ ALLEY TEXAS BI-ANNUAL EVENT

- WHEREAS, Antique Alley Texas began in September of 1999 between downtown Cleburne and downtown Grandview via E. FM 4; and
- WHEREAS, The Greater Cleburne, Venus and Grandview Chambers of Commerce, City of Alvarado, City of Venus and the City of Cleburne support the event; and
- WHEREAS, Community volunteers organize and promote the event; and
- WHEREAS, Event advertisers include individuals, businesses, the Cleburne and Venus Chamber of Commerce and the City of Cleburne; Venus and Alvarado and
- WHEREAS, The impact of the event is wide ranging, directly affecting tourism and commerce; and
- WHEREAS, The event brings more traffic to Cleburne, Alvarado, Venus and Grandview; and
- WHEREAS, Visitors patronize hotels, motels, restaurants, service stations, grocery, retail and department stores during the event; and
- WHEREAS, The traffic count is heavier on FM 4, FM 916, Hwy 67 and downtown areas of said cities during the event than any other time of the year taking roughly one hour or longer to travel fifteen miles during busy periods; and


WHEREAS, The Johnson County Sheriff's Department Reserves and the Texas Department of Public Safety patrol the event causing drivers to slow down and practice safe driving; and


WHEREAS, The goal of the Antique Alley Texas Volunteers is to involve property owners, businesses, schools, churches, other non-profit organizations, law enforcement, tourism agencies, city and county governments in all aspects of the event and establish an atmosphere that supports tourism and community events.
